## 2019 Property Crimes

CHEYENNE, Wyo.— During 2019, 1,165 property cases were sent to the Detective Bureau for review; 268 of these cases (23%) were assigned to specific Detectives for investigation.

Of the 268 cases assigned for investigation in 2019, 116 (43%) were closed and sent to the District Attorney's Office for Prosecution; 118 of those cases remain open and the remaining cases were sent to other agencies or deactivated. Property crime was reduced by 22% in 2019.
